1. We have received and read reference with interest. We have the following comments to make:

a) From the dispatch it is not clear that [] aware that CARETINA is now an UPSWING employee. It was initially only surmised that Subject's new job was to be with UPSWING, but recently CRISCHKE stated it as a fact. [] should therefore bear this in mind in any subsequent association with Subject.

b) We regret that [] did not send us the original letter from Subject, or if not the original, at least a copy thereof. If the original is still available, we would appreciate receiving copies of it. Copies should also be sent to POB. In fact copies of any further dispatches on Subject should be sent to POB. It is further requested that the indicators that appear on this dispatch be used on all subsequent CARETINA correspondence.

c) As for the letter written by CARETINA, we noted that it was received on 8 August. We assume therefore that it was written on 6 August at the earliest. This was at a time when Subject knew that his relationship with [] was at an end. We were therefore somewhat confused by Subject's mention of a meeting he was scheduled to have with [] (i.e. []), the name used by [] in Frankfurt on 13 August. We thought at first that this was perhaps an attempt by Subject to reestablish contact with [] After discussion with [] here however it became clear that this was not the case. On 5 August CARETINA stated that his new employers instructed him not to discuss his Abwehr service but that he might relate his Russian experience. When [] terminated the relationship with Subject, it was agreed that should there be any interest in a report of his experiences in Russia, Subject would be debriefed on this material in Frankfurt on 13

When [] discussed this matter in Frankfurt, there was no indication of any interest in such a debriefing, hence [] wrote Subject a note telling him not to come to Frankfurt on 13 August. This note however was not mailed until about 9 August, the date of [] departure. Hence Subject did not know that the tentative arrangements for a meeting in Frankfurt on the 13th had been cancelled until 10 or 11 August.
