<p>1. In rechecking our files on the Subject of Reference we came to the conclusion that he must be CARETINA even though the 201 listing has CARETINA as being born 1917 in Magdeburg. We discussed the matter with G. FLEMING and he confirmed that the Subject of his trace request was indeed the same man in whom KUBARK had an interest in 1956 and later. FLEMING said that CATIDE records indicated his DPOB to be that given with his EDC trace request (Reference) and that Subject himself claims to have been born at the time and place CATIDE has in its files. FLEMING said that CATIDE is still not satisfied that Subject has been entirely truthful in his story about his relationship with the Soviets during his imprisonment in the USSR. CATIDE is now attempting to research his background as thoroughly as possible, therefore the request for a EDC check. We presume that CATIDE is still in some sort of contact with him.</p> <p>2. The only other information in our files is a Memorandum for the Record, dated 10 February 1956, concerning his return from the USSR and his attempts to contact UTILITY; a copy is forwarded under separate cover for EE. We have a notation in our index that the complete file was transferred to FCB in 1959. Since addressees' files may contain voluminous traces on Subject we request that only new and pertinent information be provided.</p>
