Subject: Letter from Dr. Max HUSMANN to Joseph Gifter,
of CIC Detachment 910/58.

1. We forward a letter from Dr. Max HUSMANN, one of the Swiss intermediaries in the Sunrise Operation (well described in Sat.Eve.Post as a dedicated busybody), addressed to Guido ZIMMER, one of the two original German contacts in that operation. The letter is enclosed in a note to a certain Joseph Gifter, of CIC Detachment 910/58, whom Dr. HUSMANN referred to over the telephone as a member of O.S.S., in reply to a query by the writer.

2. We opened and read the letter, for obvious security reasons. We see no necessity for intercepting it; if you agree, kindly have it forwarded to Gifter. Being a member of the CIC Detachment, he will not have to be told why the letter was opened.

3. We would, however, like to know how Gifter met Dr. HUSMANN and why he went to see him in Zurich. For your information only, we consider Dr. HUSMANN an able but rather unscrupulous individual.

4. Incidentally, we believe that the "Handelsdirektor", referred to in the letter, is DBI.
