SUBJECT: Baron Luigi PARRILLI

1. On 15 January 1945 Abt IV, AKO Milan arrested Lt. Enrico CRAMER of the General Hqs. of the CVL. CRAMER, interrogated by JK19, gives the following account of his arrest.

2. A few days prior to his arrest, the Gestapo^{cd} had arrested his close friend, the Marquis Uberto CRIVELLI, on suspicion of having given refuge to an Allied intelligence w/t set.

3. The day before CRAMER's arrest, Edoardo POSS, PARRILLI's brother-in-law, invited CRAMER to come to his office at Corso del Littorio 10 the following day to see, if with the aid of PARRILLI, something could be done to secure CRIVELLI's release.

4. CRAMER states that he went to the office and engaged in general and inconclusive conversation with POSS and PARRILLI. After a while, two Gestapo agents came into the office and placed CRAMER under arrest, while PARRILLI burst out into laughter. At this time, POSS begged CRAMER to believe that he did not know his telephone was tapped. Over the telephone CRAMER had used only the name of Enrico. To his later demand during interrogation, CRAMER was told that PARRILLI had been responsible for his arrest.

5. Successively, CRAMER was sent to the Bolzano concentration camp, but escaped en route into Switzerland.

6. On 26 April 1945, on the basis of CRAMER's statement immediately after his return to Italy, POSS was arrested. However, CRAMER himself intervened to secure his release on the grounds that while he was certain of PARRILLI's responsibility, he could not be sure of POSS' complicity.
