1. Since writing reference dispatch the Bureau of Immigration and Naturalization has informed the Department of State that their records show Subject was admitted to the U.S. at New York as a temporary visitor on the following occasions:

- Arrived 16 Dec 1946      Departed 5 Feb 1947
- Arrived 18 April 1947      Departed 17 July 1947
- Arrived 24 Sept 1947

2. On the occasion of his last arrival he was admitted for a period of 6 months. Although a record of his departure has not yet been found, the New York office of the Bureau received a letter, dated 3 January 1948, from Mr. Howard A. LEWIS, Vice-President, Nash-Kelvinator Corp., reading in part as follows:

"On Friday, Nov 13th, the writer visited Baron Luigi Parrilli at Intra, Lake Maggiore, Italy. Baron Parrilli had been for some time at the Sonnat Sanatorium, Lucerne, Switzerland. He was visiting his father-in-law at Intra, Lake Maggiore, Italy, telephone number Intra 9874. He is suffering from a heart condition and I found his future plans uncertain. This has reference to his return to the U. S.

"Your office can reach him at the address given, because if he should return to the Sanatorium, they will forward the communication."
