CAISSON 2	Some privacy in housing.	Secret ink, micro-dot
CAISSON 2a	Sufficient privacy.	Secret ink. Micro-file if technically capable.
CAISSON 2b	Little privacy, facilities to hide radio	Secret ink, radio.
CAISSON 2c	Little privacy, possible facilities hide radio.	Secret ink. Radio?
CAISSON 8	Communications specialist of chain setup, radio operator candidate, art training.	Radio, microdot, microfile.
CAISSON 10	Little privacy, possible facilities for hiding radio.	Secret ink. Radio?

CAITIFF	Technical knowledge. Necessity transmit lengthy reports. Possible radio candidate.	Secret ink, microdot. Radio?
CALABAR 8	Radio operator candidate	Radio
CALABAR 9	Radio operator candidate	Radio
CALABAR 21	Some privacy. Necessity furnish lengthy reports.	Secret ink, Leica for microfile.
CALAMUS 2,3,4	Communications set up. Subjects educated, but little technical knowledge.	Secret inks, microfile, codes.
CALDRON 3	Privacy, clever, no technical knowledge	Secret inks, code.
CALESA 8e	Art training and ability. Some privacy. Long documentary reporting	Microfile, secret inks.
CALIPER	Technical knowledge. Short reports, observations.	Secret ink, Leica
CANIS	Privacy, no technical knowledge	Secret inks, Leica
CAPOTE	Chain, large production, radio possibilities, privacy, some technical know-how.	Secret inks, microdot, radio.
CAPRICE	Little privacy, no reporting on regular basis.	Secret ink and/or code.
CAPRIOLE	Privacy, little reporting	Secret ink.
CAPSICUM	Little privacy, very delicate position, possibly very long and highly technical reports.	Secret ink, microdot and microfile(?)
CAPSTONE	Privacy, long and detailed reports, no technical knowledge	Secret ink, microfile.

CAPTAIN	Privacy, little reporting but possibility of large detailed reports.	Secret ink, micro-file.
CAPTIVE	Technical knowledge, short reports, observations.	Secret ink, micro-file with Leica.

2. All the above cases would need at least one concealment device, but more if possible.

3. This list represents a minimum requirement at present, to which additions will be made as the questions brought up in KAPOK B-251 are resolved. This will give you an idea of the magnitude of our problem from the operational prop angle. Any more detailed information which is desired can be furnished at short notice. It might be a good idea to have the Secret Section study the PASTIME sheets on these specific agents, and possibly the files, to get more intimately acquainted with the specific problems.
