1. As you are aware, the evacuation of non-combatants and staff personnel from Germany is being carefully planned. If and when the staff is evacuated, the question what they will do and how they will continue to live after they have reached their destination must be solved.

2. In talking this over with a representative of EUCOM, it was suggested that we be prepared to go on the economy in France, North Africa or England for the immediate post-aggression period, at least. Army, Air Force and Navy units stationed in those areas will be ill-prepared for the attachment of large numbers of extra personnel, and it appears to be impossible at this time to make arrangements for any such attachment.
