1. When the new priority list of targets came from Washington this spring (per [redacted]) it became apparent that most of our assigned targets had priority over PASTIME efforts. Therefore [redacted] made the decision to shift our personnel to more important missions while not giving up any stay-behind assets already on hand. Those PASTIME agents in training would complete their work and then be put away until the outbreak of war. No further recruiting would be carried out.

2. This decision caused the following shifts:

a. [redacted] and [redacted] were not assigned to PASTIME as planned but were split up [redacted] being assigned to BEPEX and [redacted] to DIZTAG.

b. [redacted] was given the task of supervising the w/t training by [redacted] of the following (with [redacted] in an advisory capacity):

- CALAMUS 2a
- CAUL (later dropped)
- CATARACT 2
- CAGLIO 2 (hired to train w/t operators)
- CATTY 4

In addition [redacted] was given CAPSULE 28 I, now being trained by [redacted] with [redacted] acting in an advisory capacity.

c. [redacted] was to supervise CAJUN 2.

d. No changes were contemplated in the PASTIME efforts of DYCLEVIER.

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3. The VULTURE program will not be carried out to any greater extent but the STR-1 sets will be replaced by [] and [] with the new RS-1s.

4. We do not have sufficient personnel here at BOB to warrant a more comprehensive PASTIME effort.

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
