FBSTEAM Budget Estimate for FY 1951

Reference (a): Memorandum for ADPC of 28 October 1949
(Enclosure a)

1. The project FBSTEAM provides for the utilization of the services, experience and background of Stephen H. Holcomb (a) to assist the officers of OPC in their planning of operations, and (b) to make available the services of Holcomb to various other agencies of the United States Government on the consultative basis. It is recommended that this project be continued through the FY 1951.

2. Holcomb will be located outside the OPC Headquarters in the RUEBY office. He will be brought to OPC Headquarters from time to time for meetings. Holcomb will use his real name and his cover will be that he is doing private research in connection with the writing of his memoirs and acting as an intermittent consultant to the Department of State. Arrangements are being made with I&S/CIA to extend his clearance for another year until 1 July 1951.

3. The responsibility for handling all matters connected with Holcomb shall be lodged in the EE Division in cooperation with Staff II/OS. Under the general direction of the Chief, EE Division, the Acting Chief, EE/Plans will direct OPC activities connected with Holcomb. All requests for meetings with or information from Holcomb should be handled through EE/Plans.

4. The types of intelligence and other material which will be distributed to Holcomb will in general follow the lines set forth in reference (a). The committee set up by this memorandum to screen material for transmission to Holcomb has been disbanded and a new committee constituted consisting of:
