<p>A. ECMA-17861, 8 October 1959 B. DIR 39570, 14 August 1959</p> <p>1. Please inform the BfV that KUBARK does not plan any action in the PEKELSKY case. We are not aware of any other AIS interest in PEKELSKY at the present time.</p> <p>2. We have no details on PEKELSKY's current contact with the Czech IS. However, the following additional details to the information reported in reference B may be passed to the BfV:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">a. The source of the information on PEKELSKY is located in Prague and has access to information on Czech Intelligence activity. Previous reports from this source which we have been able to check have been uniformly accurate. In no instance has the source submitted information known to be false.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">b. In Vienna in approximately 1956 PEKELSKY and his wife were being handled by Stanislav TOMES, a staff officer of the Foreign Intelligence Directorate of the Czech Interior Ministry. In 1959, when source reported this information, TOMES was no longer the officer responsible for the case.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">c. PEKELSKY and his wife were both active Czech IS agents as late as 1959.</p> <p>3. The following are our comments and may also be passed to the BfV:</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">a. Stanislav TOMES, born 22 November 1925, is an identified staff officer of the Foreign Intelligence Directorate of the Czech Interior Ministry. He was stationed in Vienna as a Third Secretary of the Czech Legation from 1954 to 1957. Since his assignment to Prague in 1957, we have record of the following foreign trips made by TOMES:</p> <div style="margin-left: 80px;"> <p>April 1957 to Belgium and France July 1957 to the Netherlands April 1958 to Switzerland September 1958 to Austria March 1959 to Austria July 1959 to Switzerland</p> </div> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">A photograph of TOMES is attached for retention by the BfV.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">b. PEKELSKY and his wife attended both sessions of the Geneva Foreign Ministers Conference held in May and July 1959. Both were frequently observed in Geneva bars where they engaged in conversation with journalists and officials in Geneva who were connected with the conference. We have no evidence of their contact with CIS officers in Geneva, but assume that the PEKELSKYs were in Geneva on behalf of the Czech IS.</p> <p style="margin-left: 40px;">c. On the basis of the information from our source, which we consider reliable, we feel that BfV investigation of the PEKELSKYs would well be worth the effort involved. We will notify the BfV of any additional information on the PEKELSKYs which comes to our attention.</p>

<p>d. We request that the information from our source be tightly held and that under no circumstances should PEKELSKY be told that his meetings with TONES are known to a German agency.</p> <p>4. MOB/LD: The information on PEKELSKY comes from a sensitive source.
