PEKELSKY, Vladimir</i> DOB: 3 January 1920 POB: Bratislava, CSSR <i>Trace Request</i></p> <p>Vladimir PEKELSKY was formerly of interest to the SDU/German Element. A letter from KUBARK indicated he was dropped with prejudice effective 23 October 1952 because of lack of value in his reports. It also was rumored that he was of interest to the Italian Intelligence Service.</p> <p>2. Since the Central Registry cannot release this information to the Canadians it is requested that any releasable information be provided to the Ottawa Station for appropriate passage to the interested Canadian agency.</p>
