<p>1. It appears that your file on Maria PEKELSKY [ ] and her husband, Vladimir PEKELSKY [ ] may be incomplete.</p> <p>2. Munich Base files show that Headquarters information from a sensitive source stated that both have been agents for the CSSR MV since 1956. (DIR 39570 dated 14 Aug 59).</p> <p>3. It appears that CAVATA opened an investigation of the PEKELSKY's on the basis of this information and at WOFIRM suggestion. (EGMA-18300 dated 11 January 1960).</p> <p>4. The CAVATA investigation continued in 1961 as mentioned in EGMA-21503, dated 29 June 1961. In this document it was stated that CAVATA learned in June 1961 that Vladimir PEKELSKY was then an agent of CAVIRIL.</p> <p>5. We have no later information regarding the CAVATA investigation of the PEKELSKY's, nor do we have any info on Maria's employment, but it would appear from reference that they are still pursuing the case. It would be particularly interesting to know how CAVATA resolved the question of CAVIRIL's then running an agent (PI) who was known to be a CIS agent as late as 1959.</p>
