1. Transmitted herewith are eighteen reports resulting from further debriefings of the Source of Fall 'MITTWOCH'. These reports concern several officers of the Czechoslovak Intelligence Service of the Ministry of Interior (MV) and their activities in recruiting or attempting to recruit agents targetted against the Federal Republic of Germany.

2. One of these reports concerns Jaroslav NEMEC, case officer of Department 6 (Counterintelligence) of the Ministry of Interior, and includes a personal description of NEMEC which we hope will satisfy the referenced request. A similar report on the Czechoslovak case officer TOMES has been requested of our Headquarters and will be forwarded when received.

3. Many of the reports enclosed herewith are also being passed to the Federal Intelligence Service by our office in Munich.

4. We would be most interested in any comments you may have about these reports, and in any information you may have, or might in the future develop, on the Subjects of these reports. We will be happy to service any further questions which may arise. We wish to remind you, however, that Source's resettlement date is fast approaching, and since servicing of requests will take considerably more time after he is resettled, we would appreciate receiving any queries you may have for Source as soon as possible.
