

"The Communist University of the Working People of the Far East" *

The Following additional information would be greatly appreciated :

1. Particular information on branches of the University.
2. Names of some of the students, where they go after graduation, the types of Communist activities they conduct after graduation - perhaps some case histories.
3. All particulars of any connection between the USSR and the Japanese Communist Party that the Professor knows of.
4. A similar report to the one written by the Professor, entitled "The Communist University of the Working People of China", would be very helpful. This paper would of course deal with the organization known as Sun Yat-sen University.

If such a report is prepared, it would be desirable to give the full names, rather than merely the surnames, of the Chinese referred to therein.

5. In view of the language ~~and~~ difficulties and other obstacles to instruction mentioned in the first report, it seems surprising that the University (Far East) can turn out within the short period of two or, in the case of those students who have had no previous schooling, four years graduates who are highly trained in politics and Marxist subjects. It seems worthy of note that training is almost entirely restricted to politics and Marxist subjects and that the University apparently turns out no students prepared for professional or technical work.

It would therefore be interesting to know whether there are other technical or professional schools in the Soviet Union, attended by Communists drawn from other countries, which would lessen the dependence of Communists in backward countries upon the Western educated professional groups.
