1. Herewith is some material which may be of value to Dr. Nikolai Poppe in his desire to obtain a definitive picture of the facts concerning the Soviet-Chinese agreement, as requested in reference (b).

2. Enclosed are (a) a clipping from the "New York Times" of 15 February 1950, giving the text of a communique announcing the treaty between the Soviet Union and China; (b) a copy of the Daily Report of Foreign Radio Broadcasts, No. 32, 1950, in which are given the treaty text and the text of speeches given by Vyshinsky and Chen En-lai; (c) a memorandum dated 7 April 1950 by ORE/FE on "Migration of Chinese Labor Force to USSR" and "Soviet Use of Chinese Warm Water Ports". With regard to this memorandum, it is thought that Dr. Poppe's reactions to the speculations of ORE might be of interest to this office.
