1. The FE Division has supplied the following information based on specific questions concerning subject which were asked by [] as recorded in the referenced memorandum:

(a) To what extent is CIA interested, if at all, in subject?

Answer: Subject is cleared for a CIA consultant.

(b) Is subject considered by CIA to be reliable?

Answer: Yes

(c) If subject wishes to remain in the U.S.A., would MI-6 be able to talk to subject:


Answer: There is no reason why MI-6 should not talk to subject, *so far as CIA is concerned.*

(d) If subject wishes to work for the British, what salary would he expect?

Answer: CIA has no idea re subject's salary.
