Naturalized US citizen. Came to US 1947/48. First in Detroit then in Washington D.C. (Americ.Sec.And Trust.Co) Believed to be in FBI service. Sells shares to Latvians in Wash. Expelled from absent fraternity "Lettonia" because of collaboration with communists in 1941. Believed to be an informer to the NKVD. Traced people during the deportation time July 1941. Known as ambassador. (a)

PORMANIS Viktors, born about 1913, attended 2nd Riga town gymnasium from about 1932 to 1937. There were rumors in 1941, after the retreat of the Red Army from Latvia, that V.P. was an informer of NKVD and that due to his activity several members of "Lettonia" were arrested and deported.

According to the info of LAUBERTS Aleksandrs, employee of the VOA, Latvian desk, who knows the family of V.P. from the time in Latvia, the first name of V.P. was formerly not Viktors or Victor but Vitolds. As far as A.Lauberts knows, V.P. had worked for the NKVD in 1940/41, then arrested by the SD but soon set free to work for the SD. A.Lauberts admits that now V.P. might be working for the FBI. A.Lauberts knows also the brother of V.P. and stated that some relatives of V.P. were deported by the Soviets during 1940/41. (C).

About the activity at the NKVD of V.Pormanis known in 1940/41 knows also his schoolmate, VITOLS Janis - 3223 North Twentieth St., Arlington, Va. (C).
