Believed employed in Foreign Department of Radio City Branch, Chase National Bank, NYC.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">- RUC -</p> <p><i>This is the result of an FBI investigation and is not to be considered as a clearance.</i></p> <p>DETAILS: Confidential Informant T-1, of known reliability, has previously furnished information that the subject received correspondence from GAIDA PORMAN at 100 West 55th Street, Apartment 9E, New York City.</p> <p>Mr. CARL GRONVALD, Superintendent at 100 West 55th Street, advised that Apartment 9E at that address is rented by a Mr. LEOPOLD DESEGNI, a well-known art dealer in New York City. According to GRONVALD, DESEGNI has been traveling in Italy since the Spring of 1951 and his apartment has been occupied by two younger women whom he knows as "Mrs. PARNELL and Miss PETERSON". GRONVALD stated that these two women were of foreign extraction but he knew nothing further concerning their background. He stated that the subletting of the apartment had been handled by G. VITAGLIANO, a real estate broker at 129 East 55th Street, New York City.</p> <p>Mr. GIUSEPPE VITAGLIANO, of 129 East 55th Street, advised that he had sublet Apartment 9E at 100 West 55th Street, in April of 1951, to Miss RUTA PETERSON and Mrs. PARNELL-PORMAN. He readily identified a photograph of the subject's wife as the latter.</p>

VITAGLIANO stated that in June of 1951, Mrs. PORMAN had commenced employment in the Foreign Department of the Radio City Branch of the Chase National Bank.

VITAGLIANO's file contained no derogatory information concerning GAIDA PORMAN.
