<p>....Karel ROUBICEK had in his possession many documents, pictures, clippings, etc. which indicated that he might be a strong opponent of the present Communist regime in Czechoslovakia. He advised that there is a strong underground movement in Czechoslovakia ready to overthrow the present regime. This movement is directed by subject, <u>General Lev PRCHALA</u>, who is in London, England, General Sergej Inger, and General Karel Moravek, who are in the United States, but he wasn't able to advise as to their exact address....Roubicek's chief concern is to get to the United States to contact Inger and Moravek and then all will go to London to contact PRCHALA. PRCHALA, according to subject, advocates a federation with Poland which is not in accord with the tenets of the other four persons. He is positive that a meeting will dissuade him of his beliefs and unite the two groups into one to fight the common enemy.</p>
