Loss of prestige by Gen. PRCHALA among emigres in Germany.

Date of information: September 4th 1950

General PRCHALA's visit to Germany has been a disappointment to his followers. It showed that he was politically quite illiterate. The vagueness and hollowness of his political declaration of program caused general surprise. His rallies were remarkable for the surprisingly small number of persons who came to attend (e.g. in MURNAU) In VALKA his adherents grumble that he did not come and see them in Camp. According to a so far quite unconfirmed report he has been in NUREMBERG but only asked some of his most faithful followers to see him.

The PRCHALA-group in Camp VALKA is disintegrating. One of its leading spirits, the very active BRITNIK has resigned from it. His role has been taken over by one WYSLIYER, who seems to have been in Germany since 1945 and who has not been passed in screenings for being a Nazi collaborator.

The "Labour" Party ( Strana Prace) and the Czechoslovak Institute Abroad.  
(Ceskoslovensky Zahranicni Ustav)

Members of this party in Camp VALKA.

According to information received from Oldrich CERNY, the student \*  
HEIDLER and \*TILL have been acting as adherents of the "Labour Party and  
the Institute abroad. Both of them are and have been before escaping  
abroad decidedly social-democrats. After HEIDLER arrived in Germany  
the rumour followed him that he had taken a positive attitude to the  
February communist coup. - TILLER was followed to VALKA by his fiancée  
\*HARTMANOVA. - No members of the Czech Socialist party in Camp VALKA  
have declared their adherence to the "Labour"-party.

NOTE: as regards the "rumour" that HEIDLER had condoned the communist  
Coup d'Etat in Czechoslovakia, we know that a number of Socialists  
did so, until the new regime began stepping onto their own toes.  
But apart from this, we also know how viciously rumours in Camp  
have been ruining persons reputations, and we should therefore  
suggest that you ignore this "rumour," until and unless it is more  
definitely substantiated.

Subject : Collaborator of the  
French Intelligence  
Service in Valka.

According to information by our person of confidence -  
Oldrich Cerny, the former leader of the Prchala movement, Bittner  
is supposed to co-operate at the camp Valka with the French intelli-  
gence service. / It is stated that Bittner has just resigned from  
the camp organization of the Czech National Group - the Prchala  
movement /. He is in touch with Meizner, a 21 year old employee of  
the German camp administration, who speaks good German and interro-  
gates new refugees and submits such material to the CIO. Meizner  
draws Bittner's attention to interesting things and the latter passes  
them on to the French.
