PRESIDENT BUSH'S FAREWELL VISIT TO CIA EMPLOYEES  
FRIDAY, 8 JANUARY 1993  
MAIN CAFETERIA

1. President Bush is planning to visit CIA Headquarters on Friday, 8 January 1993, for a farewell address to all Agency employees. The President is scheduled to arrive at the Agency at 11:30 a.m. He will arrive at the Main Entrance of the Original Headquarters Building (OHB) and go directly to the seventh floor for a luncheon. Following the luncheon (approximately 1 p.m.), the DCI will escort the President to the Main Cafeteria where he will address Agency employees.

2. Employees are encouraged and welcome to greet the President when he arrives at 11:30 a.m. and again as he makes his way through the building to the Main Cafeteria at 1 p.m. The President will walk to the cafeteria starting at the first floor Main Lobby, OHB, and walk down the "D" Corridor to the "C" Corridor, past the DCI portraits to the south entrance to the cafeteria.

3. Employees under cover should be aware that members of the White House press pool will accompany the President to the Agency. The press will be allowed in the OHB lobby when the President arrives and will be in a designated area of the cafeteria where they will be limited to taking only photos of the President and DCI as they speak. Following the President's address to Agency employees, the President and his party will depart the building, walking back down the "C" Corridor to the "D" Corridor and exiting from the Main Entrance of OHB.

4. Employees located in Agency buildings other than headquarters are encouraged to take advantage of the Agency shuttle in traveling to headquarters for this event. Employees who use the VIP parking lot should keep in mind that this area may be closed during the President's visit.
