**President Bush's Address  
to  
Agency Employees  
Friday, 8 January 1993  
1300 Hours - Main Cafeteria**

1300: Mr. Gates and Admiral Studeman will escort the President and General Scowcroft to the cafeteria via the DCI's elevator to the first floor--down the "D" corridor to the "C" corridor, past the portraits, making a right on "J" corridor, past the Credit Union, turning left on "F" corridor, down to the north entrance of the Main Cafeteria.

All those who have participated in the luncheon and the Community briefings will be escorted to the cafeteria via the red elevators. They will be informed they will need to move quickly in order to get to the cafeteria ahead of the President's party.

As the President arrives in the cafeteria, a military band will be queued to play "Hail to the Chief."

1310: The DCI welcomes and presents the President.

The President addresses the Agency population assembled in the cafeteria for approximately 5 minutes.

1315: The President and his party depart CIA. They will exit through the south side of the cafeteria in order that the President may meet and greet the maximum number of employees. They will proceed down "C" corridor, make a left on "D" corridor to the main entrance.

The DCI and DDCI will escort the President and his party to their car.
