Per discussions with [redacted] during his TDY to Headquarters in July 1968, we are again raising the subject of [redacted] liaison with QKACTIVE components in London with MANOGOFF. We recognize the merit in such contact and have every confidence that it would be conducted in a manner which would not embarrass QKACTIVE or WOFIRM, but are unfortunately obliged to have his concurrence in view of his overriding responsibility for QKACTIVE's effective operation. To date, he has not softened his opposition to the proposal which stems not only from his concern about possible contamination of Identity 1 of reference a. but from his feeling that any such contacts should be only with WOLADY nationals, which would mean re-staffing both sub-projects.</p> <p>2. Pending our attempt to resolve this matter with MANOGOFF, the following background on his dealings with SMORANCE officials on the subject may be of interest. Any further [redacted] comments which will help make the case to MANOGOFF will of course be welcomed.</p> <p>3. MANOGOFF's contacts with SMORANCE officials took place during the period 30 July - 3 August 1958, when he met with two senior LCBEPFORE officials. [redacted] was requested in DIR 33210 to arrange for these contacts. We have no written record of [redacted] action taken nor of MANOGOFF's conversations. Apparently he was encouraged to begin developing plans, because under date of 8 June 1959 Headquarters authorized him to make a firsthand investigation in London and offering to arrange a contact with [redacted]. Based on this authorization, MANOGOFF requested [redacted] to develop plans.
