<p>1. From time to time during the past few months, [] has informally raised with [] the subject of moving the QKACTIVE Latin American Program (LAP) from Munich to Rome. (The possibility of relocating LAP in Rome was first brought to [] attention in January 1968 when it was decided to postpone discussion of the proposed move until the Italian elections of May 1968 were held and the QKACTIVE Book Program had moved to Rome.) It has been the [] position that moving an organization such as LAP to Rome would be inadvisable due to the unsettled political situation during the summer and fall of 1968 and due to the possibility of a Parliamentary inquiry into SIFAR.</p> <p>2. With the formation of the Rumor government in December 1968, providing Italy with a certain degree of governmental stability, [] wanted to ascertain if there had been any change in the [] position regarding the LAP relocation. Consequently, a meeting attended by [] and IDENTITY was arranged for 14 January. At the meeting [] laid that the [] position was substantially unchanged. [] first reviewed those objections previously noted in Paragraph 4, OIRA-48734, 24 January 1968 and in [] 6618, 29 July 1968. He then said that the continuing and increasing importance of the Italian Communist Party, the relative weakness of the Rumor government and the continuing interest in intelligence and intelligence-related activities sparked by the Parliamentary investigation of SIFAR make the operational climate for an activity such as LAP unfavorable. nor the government would be able or willing to do much to minimize the impact of such a flap, and that the LAP connection with TPLINGO (and possibly the Book Program) and, hence, WOFIRM would not be difficult to ascertain.

3. [], who is understandably anxious to have LAP in Rome, wanted to learn the [] attitude before formally bringing up once again the matter of the LAP relocation. [] advised [] that he could still make a request for the change of location through his own channels. [] noted, however, that Headquarters would request and take due notice of [] [] views on the proposed move.
