REFERENCE: EGMW-5305, dated 18 December 1957 *copy sent to Mr. Meyer*

1. Although you were not present, his deputy and I believe one other member of the BGACTRESS staff discussed this point with and me in office a few days before I shoved off. At that time I agreed entirely with their position, which was exactly as expressed in reference. also agreed.

2. Receipt of the reference makes one wonder if we have been in any way violating this agreed position. With the exception of packing off on "vacation" we cannot recall having issued any instructions to any of the staff agents in the overt projects. The decision, incidentally, was concurred in by et al. If BGACTRESS is saying such before they are hit, there is no problem. If, however, we have inadvertently been treading on toes, it would be useful to be told specifically what we have done.
