Attached for your information is a report concerning the identity of the student speaker on the tapes brought back from the Moscow Youth Festival by Peter SCHAMONI, Munich University student. The report positively contradicts the speaker previously identified as BUKHANGOV in the referenced report of 17 August 1957 and thus the identity of the speaker on the Moscow tapes remains unknown.

At first it appeared that the alleged student speaker was Victor BUKHANOV as described in the 17 August report. Presently, information has been obtained which definitely excludes the possibility that the speaker was BUKHANOV.

Yesterday I had a telephone call from Peter SCHAMONI who told me that he had had a preview of the documentary films taken in Moscow. He also said that ^{Alexander} DOLBERG was present at the showing of the films. Later on, DOLBERG telephoned me and asked whether he could see me as he had prepared a short paper on the contact man between SCHAMONI and the speaker on the Moscow student tape.

When I met DOLBERG, he handed me the enclosed description of Samuel PAVLOV, the contact man. Furthermore, DOLBERG added that he had to change his mind and admit that he had erroneously identified as Victor BUKHANOV the speaker on the Moscow tapes. During the showing by SCHAMONI of the documentary films taken in Moscow, the speaker of the Moscow tapes appeared on the screen and was pointed out to DOLBERG. The latter is now definitely convinced that he never had personally met this man and that it could not have been Victor BUKHANOV. DOLBERG explained part of the misunderstanding by the fact that SCHAMONI's English is not sufficiently adequate to differentiate between "I know him" and "I know about him". When SCHAMONI had reported to DOLBERG in German that the speaker had "known DOLBERG", the latter was misled to think of BUKHANOV for various similarities that were actually characteristic for the speaker. Now DOLBERG thinks that what had seemed to him an identification of the speaker is more than doubtful and he tends to believe that he never had known the speaker personally. It is now likely, however, that the speaker had heard and had known about DOLBERG which probably led to the misunderstanding on SCHAMONI's part.

ав в 1949 году. Вернулся в 1955 году. Павлов кончил десятилетку
в 1950 году. Учился в геодезическом институте, но был после первого
семестра исключен за неуспеваемость. В 1951 году призван во флот.
Демобилизован по состоянию здоровья весной 1956 года. Осенью того
же года поступил в Московский университет на филологический факультет.
Во время пребывания во флоте печатался в военной газете /рас-
сказы/. Настроен резко антисоветски и проамерикански. Регулярно
встречается с иностранцами, говорит по-английски.

Петер Шаменн встретился с Павловым на пятый день пребывания в
Москве. Предварительно он попросил переводчика ~~или~~ немецкой делега-
ции позвонит Павлову по телефону и договориться о месте встречи.
При этом переводчику было сказано, что Шаменн и Регенберг познако-
мились с Павловым уже в Москве. Встреча произошла в тот же день в
пять часов у памятника Пушкину. Павлов представил Шаменн и Регенбе-
рга "Дикю", который и записал через несколько дней на магнитофон
свое мнение о фестивале и о политике в стране вообще. Павлов ~~еще~~
встречался с Шаменн и Регенбергом еще несколько раз. Он также на-
ходится в постоянном контакте с корреспондентом "Дейли геральд" в
Москве Денем Дарримером.

On 26 August 1957, while conversing with Subject on the identification of the speaker on the tapes brought back from Moscow by SCHAMONI, Subject mentioned to Source that he had seen Tony REGENBURG who had brought him a message from his father. (REGENBURG had visited DOLBERG's family while he was in Moscow at the Youth Festival). Subject's father wrote in conciliatory terms without reproaching his defection.
