Radio Broadcasts

Source reports that since 14 October 1957 at 7:30 AM there has been a jamming of Mikhailov Committee Radio which broadcasts on 9727 KH (Shortwave), making the broadcasts impossible to monitor. The jamming consists of a loud sawing noise which repeats a cycle of 1 minute 5 seconds noise followed by 4 seconds of silence. Source would like to know if you are aware of this jamming and also if you have any knowledge of whom the jammers might be.
