1. In accordance with the understanding outlined in reference a., OSTENT has designated a working party to draft its contribution to the Subject papers, composed of Identity 1. KEYSTONE will be notified as soon as this contribution is ready for consideration by the combined KEYSTONE-OSTENT working group. It would seem that all interests would be served if an Identity 2 working party were brought in at approximately the same point as that on which it entered the preparation of previous country papers, unless KEYSTONE perceives some reason for its earlier participation.

2. It is OSTENT's opinion, in connection with the question raised in reference b., that the views of KEYSTONE, Moscow, should be solicited only after the first draft of a complete paper has been arrived at by the combined KEYSTONE-OSTENT working group, in order to provide Moscow with a more comprehensive picture.
