MEMORANDUM FOR: KEYSTONE

SUBJECT: Evaluation of Broadcasts at Moscow

1. During a conversation in the United States in June, Identity 1 offered his assistance to Identity 2, President of Identity 3, in obtaining periodic evaluations of Identity 4 in Moscow. Identity 2 has written the attached letter to Identity 1 asking that this service be initiated and providing him with background information on Identity 4 and Identity 3's objectives. Although reference is made to the Identity 5, the letter and confidential attachments reveal no governmental sponsorship of the Identity 3 and represent in appearance a follow up to an agreement between friends to perform a service for a private organization.

2. We feel that the evaluations offered by Identity 1 would be of great value to Identity 4 and we would appreciate your forwarding this material to Moscow, signifying your approval of the procedure.

3. When you have indicated your approval, we will forward a message from Identity 2 to his Munich office to commence sending to Moscow two programs a month in English transcription.
