Biographical and Assessment Questionnaire on DS-805

ACTION REQUIRED: For your information

1. In compliance with reference we are forwarding herewith as Attachment A, the results of CABEZONE Stage I interrogations of Subject. On the basis of this information, supported by the ICFLUTTER, Subject was blacklisted as a suspected Soviet agent. Information copies of Attachment A were forwarded to UPSWING who then further disseminated this information to the Foreign Office, CAVATA, and the Ministry of Interior. We were informed by @ CAESAR that the above mentioned agencies, on the basis of the information contained in Attachment A, share our opinion that DS-805 is an RIS dispatch.

2. In view of the above it is felt that involvement with Subject would damage KUBARK prestige and cause many needless complications. Specifically, the use of Subject by an ODYCKE agency could cause rather serious embarrassment for KUBARK vis a vis UPSWING and other German agencies.

3. In the future CABEZONE will furnish MOB with the Biographical and Assessment Report on each blacklisted source. We hope that Attachment A will be of help to you in convincing the interested people of Subject's unreliability and discourage them from contacting him, or even worse, employing him.
