SUBJECT: Greek Project Exploitation

1. At present the Audience Research Department has over 100 completed and partially processed returns from the Greek Project. We have now reached the point where exploitation of this material is to commence and certain steps, if taken immediately, will greatly enhance the value of this material in the appropriate HQ offices.

A. The information contained in the completed questionnaires will be processed by Hollorith (IBM) cards, either through RFE's machines or commercially, since RadLib has no IBM machine and McBee cards are not sufficient to handle the amount of data contained in the questionnaires.

B. A large number of HQ requirements were sent via BGAFTRESS/RQM to in answer to a request for same, and these requirements were included in the questionnaires. Logical recipients of the processed questionnaires will be known to BGAFTRESS/RQM, and will certainly include KUMONK and KUKNOB and appropriate REDWOOD elements.

C. In EGMA 35763, 14 July 1958, sent samples of the questionnaire in Russian and English along with photostats of one representative answer sheet in Russian and Greek. This dispatch also included a request for the number of copies of the translated answer sheets, questionnaires, etc., which would be required by HQ. This dispatch has not been answered to date.

2. In recent talks with KUKNOB representatives in Munich, discussed the feasibility of cooperation regarding the IBM cards made from Listener Reaction Reports at HQ. It was agreed that such cooperation would be beneficial. With respect to the Greek Project, therefore, it is requested that KUKNOB send their IBM code for the sections of the above mentioned questionnaire which correspond to their needs. This will enable us to use this code here in processing the questionnaires and by furnishing KUKNOB with a set of our punched cards they will then be able to accommodate the raw data to their needs without resetting the IBM machines. This can be expected to be a genuine advantage for all concerned, particularly with respect to KUKNOB's proper and efficient recording of RadLib reception data in the target area. Once the code is received here it can be utilized in processing data from other projects in the future. No coding will commence here until HQ answers this dispatch, however.

3. It is also requested that the dispatch mentioned in para. 1 C be answered, so that we can furnish HQ with the proper number of copies of translated and typed answer sheets.
