REFERENCE(S)

1. Following visit to your base last January, it has been most gratifying to note that a more smooth and harmonious relationship with the various paymar organizations had been established. Minor problems, which cropped out from time to time, were normally resolved with individual representatives from these organizations. We particularly would like to thank for his cooperation in implementing the procedures established by and for his fine performance in a liaison capacity with these organizations, which contributed to the over-all effectiveness of this program.

2. Aside from desiring to give successor a complete run-down on the procedures and changes effected since relinquished his duties in this capacity last summer, feels a meeting with representatives from TPLINGO and TPFEELING (preferably) would serve a useful purpose in clarifying any questions they may have in mind. would especially like to cover the following aspects of the program:

a. Review current procedures in effect for any suggested changes which might improve the scope of CABEZONE services to their individual organizations.

b. Discuss the relative merits of the preliminary questionnaires now being served on sources for any proposed changes which would improve their effectiveness and value to these organizations. Particular reference is made to the revised Form B questionnaire, Form 1271, and two individual questionnaires now being used by TPLINGO.

c. Discuss ways and means for working out a more effective system for making more CABEZONE sources available for personal interviews during the exploitation phase of the processing. In this connection, we might add that our scheduling system at CABEZONE is sufficiently flexible to permit interviews with sources by representatives from these organizations with a minimum of one week's advance notice.

3. Subject to your concurrence, we have tentatively arranged for to come to Munich on 29 October for this meeting. In the event this proposed date is inconvenient for any reason, please indicate an alternate date.
