1. As requested, this [] [] has discussed, on 22 June 1959, the provisions of referenced dispatch with the new Chief of DTPILLAR. As of 22 June 1959, DTPILLAR had no indigenous personnel or key contacts considered for evacuation in case of emergency. Five adults and four children make up the entire roster of DTPILLAR U. S. personnel now in Cambodia.

2. As of this date, there are no representatives of FJHUNING in Cambodia. This [] [] will forward all pertinent information should FJHUNING send representatives to this country and should DTPILLAR acquire indigenous personnel of sufficient interest to warrant evacuation in time of emergency.

1. The Fnu ORENHOV, a "White Russian," casual, unpaid informant of QUANTUM-1, is probably none other than Basil aka Vasily Vasilyevich OREKHOV. OREKHOV, born 1896 in Orel, Russia, should be well known to both Madrid and Headquarters and has been the subject of at least one burn notice, published in March 1953.

2. The list of suspects was shown to for his information; comments are forwarded herewith as an attachment. MB/CE comments are as follows:

- a. Traces on Paul VESSELOV available at MB include EGQA-87388, 12 March 1957; OSSA-5717, 26 February 1957; EGMA-25227, 8 February 1957. From these documents it appears that VASSELOV was in contact with MICHELSON, but there is no particular justification for describing VESSELOV as a Soviet agent.
- b. MB files do contain a record of the name DUDITSKIY for Wladimir HICKI; on the other hand, we also have no record of the name TOUTKINO.
- c. Mikhail KARTACHEV is the name used by FREDTECHEVSKIY in his radio broadcasts.
- d. The list appears to be a fairly typical product of an emigre intelligence peddler with contacts in the Munich emigration. For this reason we have not compiled complete traces on all of the suspects, most of whom, as you have pointed out, are well known to observers of the emigre scene.
