ZAIONCHKOWSKY offers to reveal the names of the persons involved in this nefarious business and further states he will reveal many facts "which will amaze you."</p> <p>2. Munich Base traces on ZAIONCHKOWSKY ^{SHAN} are voluminous and establish that he is an intelligence swindler and a pravaricator. <input type="checkbox"/> will advise the PBCHORD official who received this communication from ZAIONCHKOWSKY to answer him saying that PBCHORD has no interest in matters of this kind, that it is not in the intelligence business and that the information should be turned over to the German police.</p>

I am attaching for your information a copy of a letter addressed by one V. ZAIONCHKOWSKY to Jack STEWART of the Emigre Relations Division.

Jack informs me that this man has been writing to him for a period of several months about some information he wants to furnish. Jack has repeatedly requested additional details from him and this last letter seems to be about the best he can do. The letter indicates that ZAIONCHKOWSKY has information concerning a group of alleged Soviet agents who are supplying false documents to persons who could not otherwise receive an entry visa to the United States. The group is allegedly also furnishing these documents to Soviet agents being sent to America. This group allegedly gives them documentation so that these persons can enter American military plants, etc. The writer states that he will give the names of these persons and also tell many facts "which will amaze you". He claims to be working continually as an anti-Communist and would like to meet somebody to give this information to.

We have no record of ZAIONCHKOWSKY in our files and I am passing this information along to you for whatever action you deem advisable.
