MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: Col. SIEGFRID⁰ DOMBROWSKI

DATE: 9 Mar 1959

You will recall that in late December-early January, the above captioned individual left East Berlin and was subsequently surfaced at a press conference in which he alleged that he had brought with him considerable information regarding East German espionage activities and regarding personnel engaged in such activities in West Germany.

During my recent visit to Frankfurt, I inquired whether Col. DOMBROWSKI had any information regarding target areas in Munich, particularly among emigre groups and within AmComLib. I was informed at that time that Col. DOMBROWSKI appeared to have little information of value along these lines and further that he had been recently returned to Washington for further debriefing. It would be appreciated if Headquarters would be requested to question DOMBROWSKI specifically regarding his knowledge of AmComLib and emigre groups and concerning efforts being made by the Committee for Return to the Homeland and other East German organizations directed against us.
