We have not checked liaison for traces.</p> <p>2. According to a report received from DEALER (local liaison) in December 1961 Father Gustav Wetter was rector (director) of the Russicum College of the Vatican until 1954 when he was replaced in that position by Father Bohumil Teofil HGRACEK. This change, according to the DEALER report, was made because Wetter was more interested in philosophy than in trying to prevent Soviet contacts in and infiltration of the Russicum; he was therefore replaced. It is not known what position, if any, Father Wetter now holds at the Russicum.</p>
