1. [] to depart for recruiting and survey trip on or about 6 October 1951 for Europe and to return to the United States in approximately three months. [] to land in Paris for the following reasons:

- a. To buy foreign-made automobile bearing tourist TTX license plates.
- b. To be more consistent with cover.
- c. To contact possible cutouts and spotters for recruiting agents in France.
- d. Having TTX plates, gasoline is no problem for tourists in other countries.

2. [] to visit training site in Munich, Germany, and establish and set up all facilities pertaining to proposed school schedule for November and December.

3. After [] recruiting trip through Europe, he will proceed to [] for consultation and planning of project QKBROIL, and then return to the United States. After return to the United States for consultation and coordination with operations, [] to proceed back to Turkey to begin operations.

4. [] will attend covert training school and the guerrilla warfare course in Washington, terminating on or about 15 December 1951. If it is determined that a training site is to be established in Turkey, [] will proceed directly to Istanbul to set up facilities. [] to head the training section.

5. [] is to proceed to Germany on or about 1 November 1951 for a period of two to four weeks or less to observe, assist and suggest on curriculum offered at the training school. [] and [] to meet and confer at school with view to setting up school in Turkey. [] to return to United States upon completion of mission and then proceed to Turkey as soon as possible as advance party. [] to make liaison

with existing [] personnel and possible Turkish agencies.

6. [] and [] to proceed to Munich, Germany, to training site on or about 15 October 1951 to plan for assisting in training course. Both [] and [] to remain there for a period of not more than three months, thereafter proceeding to Turkey.

7. [] and to proceed to Munich on or about 1 November to assist in the training program and remain there for the entire program, and then to proceed to Turkey.

8. [] to proceed to Munich, Germany, on or about 20 October to set up medical facilities at school and also to act as translator and interpreter during the courses for the agents. [] to remain in Germany for the full course and then to proceed to Turkey.

9. [], if cleared by 1 October, to attend covert schools here in the United States, and should be ready to ship by 1 January, 1952, to be used as instructor either in Germany or in Turkey in the event the school is to be set up there.

10. [] and at least one typist to proceed to Turkey on or about 1 November to set up a liaison for administrative purposes in Turkey.

11. [] and [] to proceed to Turkey with their families. Their arrival should coincide with that of [] so that they may assist him in setting up. Tentative date on or about 15 November.

12. [] and [] to proceed to Turkey on or about 1 January 1952.
