1. It appears probable that we shall have to send over a representative of this Office to make an examination on-the-spot of the conditions which have created the present difficulties between [ ] and Hall. This person will need to be fully familiar with the background of SFG, UMPIRE and EDUCATOR, in order to be adequately briefed to do an intelligent and objective investigative job. It will, therefore, be essential that we gather together in one place the following documents - plus such other documents as you, on the basis of your long and intimate experience with this operation, will suggest to me.

a. The various documents which [ ] prepared and we concurred in in advance of his departure for the field, including his charter of mission and the two project folders (EDUCATOR and EDICT).

b. A fairly detailed historical account and analysis of SFG UMPIRE and EDUCATOR genesis, including the various plans and reversals of plans. This paper which I request you to prepare should make clear, I believe, the three aspects of this situation: What EUCOM has seen happen from its vantage point; what [ ] has seen happen from his point of view; and what OPC has seen from its point of view. This description should include a record of the fact that Mr. Wimer had certain conversations with General Clay, the nature of which he will be prepared to give to the individual, and that Mr. Offie had certain conversations with General Hall, the nature of which he will also be prepared to outline; both were on the subject of OPC.

c. The cable file of high-level exchanges between Clay and Hillenkotter, and Wedemeyer and Clay, which I believe is in Registry - Eyes Only.

d. [ ]'s principal dispatches to OPC outlining his various problems, particularly his latest dispatch of alarm and including the exchanges with reference to the printing plant and the "Neue Zeitung".
