Associated as a partner with the Souheb Mahmoudy (sic) import-export and is responsible for business transactions in Spain, France and England as he speaks and writes the languages of these countries. Rademacher was convicted of persecuting the Jews in his official capacity. He fled to Spain then to Syria.. RADEMACHER claims contact with several West German high government officials.

Subject (Born 2 Feb 1906, Nauterlitz, Germany) Counselor of Legation retired, was sentenced by the Nuremberg Court to three to five months in jail for assistance in the manslaughter of 1300 Serbian Jews. While two appeals were running, RADEMACHER was freed on a writ of his defense counsel. He fled to Syria and now lives in Damascus as a self-employed export/import businessman.
