RADEMACHER, FRANZ (DR.) [ ] [ ]  
 THE WRITER OF THE LETTER IN REFERENCE EGOA-14075 LISTED AS G. RISCHER OR FISCHER, P.O. BOX 635, DAMASCUS, SYRIA, IS ALMOST CERTAINLY DR. GEORGE FISCHER [ ] [ ] BUSINESSMAN, RUE GEORG HADDA 22/7 DAMASCUS. WHOM WE SUSPECT MAY BE IDENTICAL WITH THE FORMER SS MAJOR ALOIS ANTON BRUNNER (WE ARE CONCURRENTLY WRITING ANOTHER DISPATCH ON FISCHER AND BRUNNER). FISCHER, ACCORDING TO SEVERAL SOURCES, IS N AGENT AND ADVISOR OF THE SYRIAN GID, AND IS A CLOSE FRIEND OF DR. FRANZ RADEMACHER [ ] [ ] AKA F. BARTOLOME (TOME) ROSSELLO PLUS NUMEROUS VARIATIONS THEREOF A MEMBER OF THE GESTAPO FROM 1937-1945 AND NAZI FOREIGN OFFICE DURING PART OF WW II. SOMETIME BETWEEN 1952-54 RADEMACHER FLED FROM GERMANY TO SYRIA TO ESCAPE PUNISHMENT FOR HIS ANTI-SEMITIC ACTIVITIES DURING THE WAR. HE ALSO IS REPORTED TO BE AN AGENT AND ADVISOR TO THE SYRIAN GID.
