Government you form will succeed, and I think...." At that point General Radescu cut him off abruptly and replied, "You have thought for three months, now it is up to me to do the thinking." The second incident occurred when General Radescu learned that there was a hostile demonstration by the *Associé des Hospitaliers* (Union of Hospital Employees). With this information, he took with him his aide and Mr. Tochari, Under Secretary of State, in an automobile and went to the location of the manifestation, and said that if this demonstration is not terminated today, he (Tochari) would have to be removed. Mr. Tochari is stated to be an Under Secretary representing the party of the Left.

5. Sub-source reported that in the new cabinet Captain Caragea, personal assistant to General Radescu, would be the direct representative of General Radescu dealing with the Commission to carry out the terms of the Armistice, and also in dealing with foreign representatives.
