Since yesterday, the country has a government of broad democratic collaboration, as demanded by the mass of the people. The experiment of the government of General Radescu closed with a balance of tragic consequences for the country. Following the act of August 23, Rumania passed into the Allied camp of the democracies, where she belonged. By the Armistice Convention we undertook to rid the country of fascism, and to carry on the war against Hitlerism to the end.

Of all these things, what did General Radescu do? During his short administration, he served against the country's interests, the fascist elements preventing the introduction of true democracy that was required. He prevented the eradication of fascism, sabotaging the tasks imposed by the Armistice. He tolerated the excessive rise in living costs. He made ~~made~~ <sup>made</sup> challenging speeches that culminated in the events that took place on February 24 before the Royal Palace, when he ordered (the troops) to fire on the people which was asking him to leave. More than that: as Moscow states, General Radescu was preparing a real military "putsch".

Of all these things General Radescu is responsible. And he knows it because he is hiding. No one sees him these days.

According to certain reports, he would seem to be sheltered at one of the English agencies, knowing himself to be guilty of the nefarious policy he found fit to follow.
