Excerpt of pertinent information:

P. 2--The King then said that the factional controversy of the Rumanian exiles and their various maneuvers to advance their personal interests by exploiting him was causing him great distress in various ways. He asked how the Department would regard an effort on his part to resolve their quarreling by bringing them together in some kind of committee in which their energies could be directed to a common cause of the welfare of Rumania. He indicated that he felt that General Radescu was the logical one to head such a committee. . .

P. 5-- [The Queen Mother] indicated her displeasure over the way in which, especially since their arrival in the United States, various persons were attempting to use Michael for their own advantage. She said, "Poor Radescu certainly has had his trouble trying to get the Rumanians together." She deplotted the letter which Davila had written to her lady-in-waiting for the attention of the King. . . remarking that Davila had never been a Minister to Michael. . .
