Excerpt of pertinent information :

24. XII. 1949 FADDIST/12 The Christian Democratic Party has not been formed in the country but here during the last stay of General Nicolae Radescu. Surrounded by all sorts of unsatisfied and ambitious individuals, weak and unsatisfied himself, General Radescu creates by his ambiguous and undecided attitude an incredible state of confusion whenever he comes to Paris, state of confusion which lasts several months after his departure.

The Christian Democratic Party was conceived by Vasiliu Cluj, Misu Rautu, and Nicolae Harescu. It is meant to be a cover organization which, under the pretext that it has originated in Roumania, represents the will of the Roumanians in the country; all extra party people (Legionnaires, - in Paris and Germany-, Radescu people. General Ion Gheorghe, people in Germany, and others) will adhere to the programme of this party and thus claim a representation in the Committee and the right to dispose of the funds.

It is with these ideas in mind that Radescu went to pay a visit to the King to whom he made some hints with regard to the raise of the number of the members of the Committee. . . .
