P. 2—The fact that N. MALAXA has ceased backing General RADESCU is not in itself to be regretted. The backing of General RADESCU by a financial shark of MALAXA's species was most deplorable, but, it must be assumed that General RADESCU was compelled to accept this backing (from 1947 to 1949) for lack of any funds from any more legitimate source. . . As to the reasons for which MALAXA stopped backing General RADESCU, the writer can only submit the following possibilities: that MALAXA may have come to consider RADESCU as having no chances of ever getting power, and therefore he would be of no interest to him (MALAXA), that MALAXA can have been prevailed upon to abandon RADESCU, and thus contribute to the general liquidation of Romanian Resistance, that, in view of a possible association between the Iron-Guards and the National-Peasant Group, MALAXA might consider his future connections with the majority group, as being sufficiently assured through his Iron-Guard friends. . .

P. 3—Lately, General GHEORGHE has become most active as the leader of this group (Iron Guards), and although General RADESCU has some personal sympathy for him, has been very critical of General RADESCU, for not having included him in the Romanian National Committee. . .
