One month and a half ago, a letter was received in Paris from New York (Presumably from General Nicolae RADESCU addressed to Mihai RAUTU - author's FADDIST opinion) in which the situation of the R.N.C. is described as irretrievably split in two camps, following a proposal made by Gen. RADESCU and not heeded by the other group.

General RADESCU proposed three suggestions which, if accomplished, would have ironed out all existing difficulties: 1. The obligation for the Cretseanu group to bring the fund on the table of the Committee; 2. That LAZAR be replaced by a neutral personality; 3. That the number of the members of the Committee be enlarged.

Whatever the issue will be, the letter informs its addressee, both the State Department and the Free Europe Committee conder (sic) that General RADESCU is and will be persona grata (sic) with them, and that no Committee is to be thought without RADESCU. Further the State Department and the Free Europe Committee do not consider it essential that the Political Parties be represented.

The members of the Rumanian National Committee in New York have signed a statement to the effect that they can not reach an agreement; this document was handed to the American authorities.

This is all the pertinent information on subject in this document.
