Biography.

b. 1 Jan 20 in Turits, Poland. In Marburg since 17 October 1945. Served in Polish army 1939 and undertook underground activities with the White Russian national movement, White Ruthenian Independence Party and White Ruthenian National Guard. In 1944 came to Germany and joined Radislaw Ostrowski's White Ruthenian Central Committee training as a major with a White Ruthenian division at Grafenwohr. In addition is active in such groups as the White Ruthenian Veterans' League and is believed to have excellent connections with White Ruthenian emigre leaders as Abramchik.

Above average intelligence, strongly anti-Communist, Considerable experience in anti-Soviet CI work with White Ruthenian groups.

Egotistic, ambitious, and primarily interested in furthering White Ruthenian nationalism.
