COLLABORATION. BECAUSE AECAMBISTA 2 RECRUITED AECAMPO 11 SUPPORT PURPOSES, HE MAY HAVE REVEALED ABOVE DETAILS ON TEAM II PURPOSES HIS RECRUITMENT ONLY.

2. AECAMPO 11 HAS MET SUBJECT, REF A, BUT STATES CONTACTS LIMITED VIEW PROJECTED ASSIGNMENT. ACCORDING AECAMPO 11 MOST BYELO STUDENTS LOUVAIN KNOW REASON HIS TRIPS MUNI IN SPITE COVER STORY VIEW PREVIOUS ASSESSMENT MAJORITY STUDENTS. ALSO STRONGLY SUSPECTS AMERICAN SUPPORT AECAMBISTA 1 PUBLICATIONS.

3. CASE OFFICERS CONCLUDE AECAMPO 11 HIGHLY DESIRABLE AS TEAM MEMBER ONLY, BUT FEEL NECESSARY HEADQUARTERS EXAMINE SECURITY IMPLICATIONS HIS KNOWLEDGEABILITY, SECURITY COMPROMISE IN BELO HOME AND OF FOLLOWING:

THEREFORE, VIEW AECAMBISTA 2 INABILITY PROCURE STRONG LEADER TYPE 1954 OPS, FEEL UTILIZATION AECAMPOS 10 AND 11 POSSIBLE ONLY IN SUPPORT ROLE PROVIDING AECAMPO 10 ACCEPTABLE OR HAS NOT DEVELOPED INTO LEADER TYPE SINCE PREVIOUS ASSESSMENT. FOLLOWING ALTERNATIVES POSSIBLE VIEW NON-ARRIVAL AECAMPO 10 AND ABOVE SECURITY IMPLICATIONS:

A. RECRUIT AND TRAIN AECAMPOS 10 AND 11 EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUPPORT ROLE WITH CONCURRENT CLARIFICATION ALL SECURITY POINTS.

1. IMPROBABLE THAT CLEANLINESS TEAM II WILL BE RESOLVED PERMIT THEIR UTILIZATION SUPPORT ROLE 54 OPS. THEREFORE IF NOW RECRUITED EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUPPORT ROLE ENVISION NECESSITY HOLDING AGENT MINIMUM 15 MONTHS.

2. EVEN IF CLEANLINESS ESTABLISHED, THEIR UTILIZATION QUESTIONABLE VIEW APPARENT LAX SECURITY WITHIN AECAMBISTA 1.
