RI Document [] contains a CIC report, MCHA, dated 27 October 1948. Subject was born 1 January 1920 in Turits, Poland and has been living in Marburg, Germany, since 17 October 1945.

His career includes service in the Polish Army in 1939 and underground activities with the White Russian National Movement, White Ruthenian Independence Party, and the White Ruthenian National Guard. He came to Germany in 1944 and joined Radialav OSTROWKI's White Ruthenian Central Committee, training as a Major with a White Ruthenian division at Grafenwohr. He is believed to have excellent connections with White Ruthenian emigre leaders as Nikolai ABRANEZYK of Paris, France. Subject cannot be recommended unconditionally as he is egotistic, ambitious and primarily interested in furthering White Ruthenian nationalism.

The following documents charged to SR/3 concern Boris RAGULA, an agent used for training purposes. In approximately 1954, he entered Canada and is presently contemplating a visit to the United States. An extensive search for the files by SR/3 and SR/7 personnel proved negative.
