1. The Enneri Societa Responsibilita Limitata (S; Limited Liability Company), which has its headquarters at 12 Via Scutari in Venice and a branch at 21 Via Genoa in Trieste, was organized in Trieste in 1946. It was organized by Corrado Enneri and Emilio Massimiliano Felix. Enneri, a pharmacist, was born in Pola on 2 February 1900 and resides in Grignano Section of the Free Territory of Trieste. Felix, an Austrian citizen, was born in Budapest on 10 November 1899 and resides in Venice.

2. Enrico Rajakowitsch (aka Raja), who is the co-owner and member of the firm, is director of the Trieste office. He was born in Trieste on 23 November 1905 and resides there at 15 Via Genoa. He left Trieste in 1915, when he moved to Austria with his parents, and returned to Trieste on 8 August 1946 with his wife, Anna Maria Rintelen, and their children, Klans Antonio, aged 17, and Antje Maria, aged 8. He holds sojourn permit No. 12356, which was issued by the civil police of the Free Territory of Trieste. Rajakowitsch is known as a businessman with few scruples who is capable of undertaking any activity if it is worth his while.

3. The Enneri company handles the export and import of various merchandise, wholesale traffic in clearing, and the orders for and representation of chemical and pharmaceutical products. The Trieste branch has handled lumber, cellulose and quintals of refined black sulphur to Austria.
